## New This Week

Scott Kelley, an artist and naturalist who last year exhibited paintings of herons at the Pamela Williams Gallery in Amagansett, is back with "Oology," works in gouache, graphite, and watercolor focusing on birds' eggs and nests. The show opens with a reception Saturday from 5 to 7 p.m. and runs through Oct. 9.

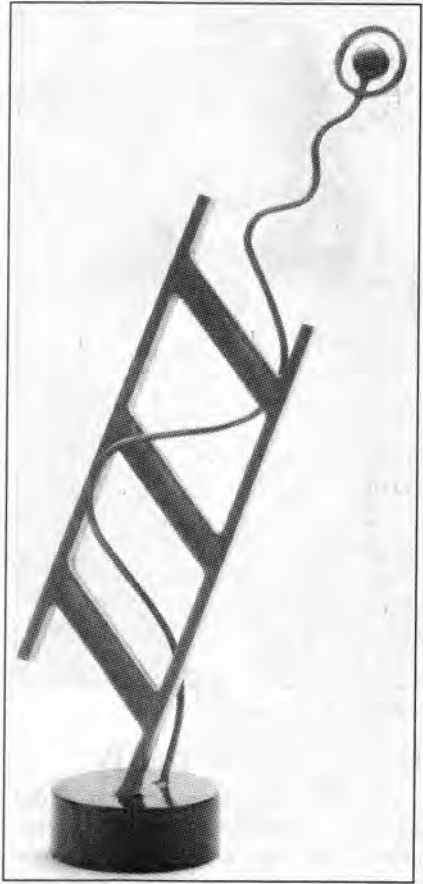
